The Verderers of the New Forest have entered into an agreement with Natural England to carry out environmental land management and capital works in the New Forest.

The objectives of the HLS Scheme will be implemented by a partnership of the Verderers of the New Forest, The New Forest National Park Authority and the Forestry Commission.

Financial Review

The Scheme has spent more in the year than its income in the year; however, this is catching up with expenditure which was planned but not made in the previous years, reducing the accrued surplus from £1,431,049 to £1,245,089. Further catching up will occur over the next few years, up to the end of the Scheme in 2020. The Scheme's assets and liabilities are reflected in the balance sheet on page 3.

Notes to the accounts For the period ended 31 December 2014

1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

Income from Natural England is recognised in the year to which the Scheme relates. Grants received after the year end that relate to the scheme year are reflected in Income as Accrued income. Any income (allocated from the year's grant) that relates to project expenditure incurred after the year end is included in creditors as deferred income. Any unallocated income is carried forward in accumulated fund. Any other income is recognised when receivable.

Expenditure

Expenditure is accounted for on the accruals basis and is recognised in the period the costs are incurred by the scheme and the project partners. Any costs not paid or paid to third parties or reimbursed to the partners before the year end are accrued and included in creditors and accruals.

2 Related party transactions

The Verderers of the New Forest, New Forest National Park Authority and the Forestry Commission are partners to the Scheme. Each partner manages a number of projects and is reimbursed by the Scheme for the expenditure incurred. Amounts paid or payable to the parties were as follows:
