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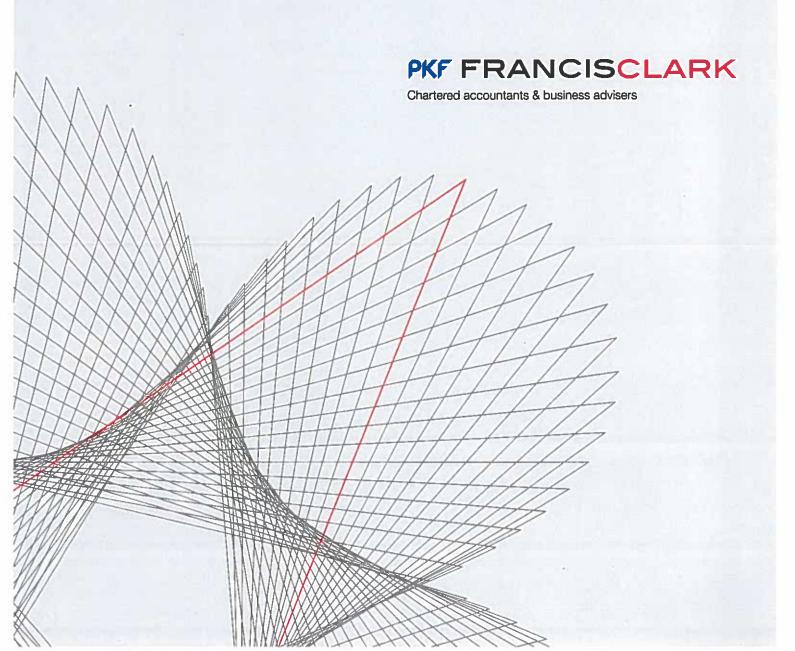

Financial Review

Notes to the accounts For the period ended 31 December 2017

1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

Income from Natural England is recognised in the year to which the Scheme relates. Grants received after the year end that relate to the scheme year are reflected in income as accrued income. Any income (allocated from the year's grant) that relates to project expenditure incurred after the year end is included in creditors as deferred income. Any unallocated income is carried forward in accumulated fund. Any other income is recognised when receivable.

Expenditure

Expenditure is accounted for on the accruals basis and is recognised in the year the costs are incurred by the scheme and the project partners. Any costs not paid or paid to third parties or reimbursed to the partners before the year end are accrued and included in creditors and accruals.

2 Related party transactions

New Forest National Park Authority and the Forestry Commission are partners to the Scheme. Each partner manages a number of projects and is reimbursed by the Verderers for the expenditure incurred. Amounts paid or payable to the parties were as follows:

The amounts payable included in the above are separately disclosed in the balance sheet.

Amounts paid to individual Verderers from the Verderers' Grazing Scheme totalled £3,514 in the year.

Financial Statements of The Verderers of the New Forest - Higher Level Scheme For the year ended 31 December 2017

1. Responsibility for the Financial Statements

I acknowledge as Official Verderer my responsibility for the financial statements which you have prepared at my request and in particular confirm that I have selected suitable accounting policies and applied them consistently and made judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent.

I also acknowledge my responsibilities for:-

- a) Keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Higher Level Scheme
- b) Safeguarding the assets of the Higher Level Scheme and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

2. Assets

All assets are included in and noted on the accounts and I have no reason to believe that any material items have been omitted.

I confirm that at the year end £1,988,205 was due to the Higher Level Scheme from Natural England.

3. Liabilities

All liabilities of the Higher Level Scheme of which I have knowledge are included in the appropriate classifications and I have no knowledge of any pending litigation or other claims against the Higher Level Scheme or any contingent liabilities or capital commitments. No liabilities are 'secured' by reason of suppliers restricting the transfer of title to goods supplied.



4. Expenditure

Expenditure has been properly allocated.

5. Completeness of Information

All the accounting records have been made available to you for the purpose of preparing the financial statements and all the transactions undertaken by the Higher Level Scheme have been properly reflected and recorded in the accounting records. All other records and related information, including minutes of all Board meetings (held during the year and up to the date of this letter) have been made available to you.

6. Going Concern

I confirm that, in my considered opinion, the Higher Level Scheme is able to continue for the foreseeable future and for at least one year from the date of this letter. In arriving at this opinion, I have considered the Higher Level Scheme's current financial position, its current level of activity and all other relevant information.

7. Post Balance Sheet Events

There have been no events since the balance sheet date which necessitate revision of the figures included in the financial statements or inclusion of a note thereto, nor which affect the Higher Level Scheme's ability to continue trading as a going concern. Should any such material events occur, I will advise you accordingly.

8. Transactions with Higher Level Scheme Board Members

The Higher Level Scheme Board members received no remuneration from the Higher Level Scheme during the year.

At the year end, £16,278 was due to the Verderers of the New Forest, £1,041,544 was due to the Forestry Commission and £86,735 was due to the National Park Authority. These organisations are members of the Higher Level Scheme.

9. Related Party Transactions

I confirm that I have disclosed to you all related party transactions relevant to the Higher Level Scheme and that I am not aware of any further related party matters that require disclosure.

10. Laws and Regulations

I confirm that there are no Laws or Regulations that are central to the Higher Level Scheme's ability to conduct its business that may have an impact on amounts or disclosures in the financial statements.
